2.	AB x1-1	Mary Engstrom (DHCS)	DHCS/Mary informed the workgroup of the status on the ABx1 1 reports. The reports will be posted onto the website and available for viewing on a rolling basis.

3.	R17.2	Chris Martinez (CalHEERS)	CalHEERS/Chris shared highlightes of key change requests that were implemented on February 13, 2017.
4.	R17.6	 DHCS Team Members Cov CA Team Members CalHEERS 	 DHCS CRs CR 70497 – This CR will modify the online single streamline application (SSApp) to meet regulatory and statuory requirements. The changes will enable consistency with the paper application. It will identify US veterans and American Indians and collect optional information like gender identify, as examples. CalHEERS/James Duckens shared with the workgroup that the scope of this change request for release will be delayed and the new target is tentatively set for R17.7. Covered California CRs CR 56179 – This CR will consolidate online provider directory for all Covered CA QHPs. The provider directory will enable consumers to conduct a search for their doctor, a dentist for their children, or hospital prior to selecting a health plan through CalHEERS. Single Streamline Application (SSApp) Transformation – Current & New CalHEERS/Amanda presented to the workgroup a "Before" and "In Progress" view of the Single Streamline Application changes that are under development and planned for implementation.
5.	R17.7	 DHCS Team Members Cov CA Team Members CalHEERS 	 DHCS CRs CR 76084 – The purpose of this CR is to work in conjunction with CR 70497. Currently, all consumers are asked the same set of questions and have to navigate through the full application. There will be checkpoints performed throughout the application process to determine what questions to display to the consumers. Covered California CRs No R17.7 Covered CA changes to highlight.

R17.9	 Rene Mollow (DHCS) DHCS Team Members Cov CA Team Members CalHEERS 	 DHCS CRS CR 64475 – DHCS/Rene shared with the workgroup the DHCS and CalHEERS have discontinued the development and plans for implementation of this change request for the Affordability and Benefit Program for New Qualified Immigrants, per the Governor's May Budget Revision (released on May 12, 2017). CR 69974 – DHCS and Covered CA requested this change to add system refinements related to immigrant eligibility. This CR will change the immigration document information fields to be optional, refine the request for the grant date, and enhance the calls to the federal hub for immigration status verification. CR 82977 – This CR will implement the State Inmate Program in CalHEERS. DHCS will be the case managers for this population. The system change will include the addition of inmate program aid codes to the manual drop-down list in CalHEERS for DHCS to administer. CR 82978 – This CR will implement the county inmate program and indicator to the CalHEERS system. CalHEERS will interface with the SAWS systems through the eHIT interface for the eligibility determination. The CalHEERS system will process the county inmate application indicator as self attestation for the Covered CA programs eligibility determination and will deny eligibility to APTC/CSR for an individual that attests to being incarcerated. CR 83286 – This CR modifies the eligibility determination request to produce a standby eligibility result that requires authorization in oder to finalize the determination and initate downstream eligibility processes. This CR will also provide functionality to CEWs to manually override CalHEERS eligibility determins based upon defined conditions. CR 82920 – This CR will modify both the CalHEERS portal and the eHIT interface architecture to add a separate verifications only service to the federal hubs, while continuing to maintain existing functionality to combine the verification and the business rules engine services.
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			 Covered California CRs CR 90113 – This CR will continue the user interface upgrades of the CalHEERS consumer portal. The focus of this change is the flow for renewal and reportachange. These enhancements are designed to increase the ease of use and understanding for the consumers when they are reporting changes or renewing coverage. CR 6614 – This CR automates the eligibility discontinuance or redetermination for consumers that fail t provide valide documentation to verify an inconsistency for income. CR 82949 – This CR optimizes the CalHEERS system for consumers who will be participating in the 2018 renewals. Enhancements includes notices, consumer portal functionality, batch processes, and portal contents.
