SUBJECT: Medication Assisted Treatment (MAT) Reimbursement Rates for Fiscal

Year (FY) 2020-21 under the Drug Medi-Cal Organized Delivery System

(DMC-ODS)

PURPOSE

This Information Notice transmits FY 2020-21 reimbursement rates for DMC-ODS MAT services, effective July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2021.

DISCUSSION

Under the DMC-ODS, Narcotic Treatment Programs (NTPs) in waiver counties are required to have available the following medications: Methadone, Buprenorphine, Disulfiram, and Naloxone. NTPs are responsible for prescribing, ordering, administering and monitoring services, and will be reimbursed with a bundled rate, which includes the costs of the drug and dosing. The DMC reimbursement rates for Methadone are reported in Behavioral Health Information Notice 20-028. Rates for Buprenorphine-Naloxone, Disulfiram, and Naloxone are listed in the Exhibit.
