FINDINGS

Finding #1: Placer County did not include a narrative description of the training provided to participants in the Community Program Planning Process (CPPP) in the adopted FY 2017-20 Three-Year Program and Expenditure Plan (Plan) and FY 2019-20 Annual Update (Update). <u>Recommendation #1:</u> The County must include a narrative description of the training provided to participants in the CPPP in each subsequent adopted Plan and Update thereafter.

Finding #2: Placer County's adopted FY 2017-20 Plan and FY 2019-20 Update did not include a description of how stakeholder involvement demonstrates a partnership with constituents and stakeholders throughout the process that includes meaningful stakeholder involvement on: mental health policy, program planning and implementation, monitoring, quality improvement, evaluation, and budget allocations. 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Recommendation #4: The County must provide an estimate of the number of clients, in each age group, to be served in the FSP service category for each fiscal year of Plan in each subsequent adopted Plan and Update thereafter
