Provide a brief summary describing how the COVID-19 Public Health Emergency inhibited the County's ability to complete and submit its Three-year Plan or annual update for FY 2021-22.

Beginning in December 2020, the Department commenced the planning process for the FY 2021-22 MHSA Plan Update. The Department's planning group continued to adapt to the prolonged effects of the COVID-19 Pandemic. A total of 17 county-wide stakeholder meetings were hosted virtually, and feedback was obtained through various Online formats such as surveys. The planning group began the drafting period in April 2021, during which the Department slowly transitioned to more face-face services and concurrently assisted the County in COVID-19 relief activities. The Plan Update was published on-line on July 16, 2021 and the Behavioral Wellness Commission hosted a Zoom hearing on August 18, 2021. The Board of Supervisors are scheduled to review and approved the Plan Update in September via a Zoom meeting. The Pandemic delayed publication in order to ensure that accurate program updates and adequate public input were received given the on-line nature of the past year. The plan update should be submitted by the end of September 2021.
