SUBJECT: Permissible and Excluded Activities (Revised)

The Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) is providing guidance to clarify the activities a community-based organization (CBO) may include as part of their outreach, enrollment, and retention efforts using Navigator Project allocations.

As a COB that directly contracts with DHCS, your organization is required to follow the terms and conditions of the Business Associate Agreement (BAA) with DHCS. The following activities are permissible/excluded under your current agreement:

Activities Under the BAA

 Enrollment: Translation activities related to enrollment or navigation services. On-site resource during outreach efforts. Conduct presentations and educate public at outreach events. Assist the beneficiary or answer questions to help complete an application. Assist with completing the Medi-Cal application and related forms. (Paper or electronic format) Assist with explaining, obtaining, and/or making required verifications for points of Medi-Cal eligibility available to the county Medi-Cal eligibility staff. 	Enrollment: - Case processing for eligibility determinations or terminations.	

Retention:	Retention:
 Cold calls/outreach to beneficiaries due for redetermination. Cold calls/outreach to beneficiaries who have been discontinued during redetermination, while still within the ninety (90) day cure period. Assist with completing Medi-Cal redetermination forms. (Paper or electronic format) Assist with explaining, obtaining, and/or making required verifications for points of Medi-Cal eligibility available to the county Medi-Cal eligibility staff. 	 Case processing for eligibility determinations or terminations.

 Navigation: Translation activities related to enrollment or navigation services. Assistance in assessing the best program options and identifying medical providers. Coordinate mental, medical and dental care visits. Provide assistance in accessing care including mental, medical and dental services. 	 Navigation: Provide transportation services to mental, medical, and dental care visits.
