Additional Comments: The North Coastal Prevention Coalition (NCPC) was contracted to implement drug prevention and intervention programs through current youth development programming through outreach efforts and social media campaigns to reduce access and the use of drugs including; alcohol, marijuana, fentanyl, and other drugs by Oceanside youth. The City of Oceanside contracted NCPC to implement an annual 420 Remix Drug Prevention campaign that included a Public Service Announcement Video and Art contests that generate youth-driven prevention messages. While there were no cash prizes, winning entries were showcased at local movie theaters, on buses, taxis and in public spaces (Cost for this advertising=\$16,095). Additionally, students attended a prevention conference and received prevention education.
