PROPOSED STATE PLAN AMENDMENT FOR THIRD PARTY LIABILITY REQUIREMENTS

This notice is to provide information of public interest about a proposed State Plan Amendment (SPA) by the Department of Health Care Services (DHCS). Proposed SPA #24-0056 updates the State Plan so that California is in compliance with third party liability requirements included in the Consolidated Appropriations Act (CAA). Proposed SPA #24-0056 incorporates requirements under section 10022 of California Welfare and Institutions Code.

DHCS estimates that the annual aggregate Medi-Cal expenditures for third party liability requirements will be budget neutral.

The effective date of the proposed SPA is January 1, 2025. All proposed SPAs are subject to approval by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS).
