

Mental Health Services Act (MHSA) Performance Review Report
San Francisco County Program Review

FINDINGS

Finding #1: San Francisco County did not indicate the number of Children, Transitional Age Youth (TAY), Adults, and Older Adults to be served, and did not provide the cost per person for each Innovation (INN) project, in the FY 2023-26 Three-Year Program and Expenditure Plan and FY 2024-25 Annual Update.
(California Code of Regulations, title 9, section 3930 (c)(4)(B), 3930(c)(4)(C)).

Recommendation #1: The County must provide evidence of compliance for the estimated number of children, TAY, adults, and older adults to be served, and indicate the cost per person for each INN project for FY 2024-25. Specifically, FUERTE (UCSF), Wellness in the Streets (RAMS), Technology-Assisted Mental Health Solutions (MHASF), and Culturally Responsive Practices for Black/African American Communities.
