

Mental Health Services Act (MHSA) Performance Review Report
Amador County Program Review

FINDINGS

Finding #1:

Amador County did not consistently enter a Full Service Partnership (FSP) agreement with all clients served under the FSP service category, and when appropriate, with the client's family, as required by Cal. Code of Regs., tit. 9, § 3620(e).

Note: The Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) defines an FSP agreement as a signed agreement between the client, and when appropriate, the client's family, and the County.

Recommendation #1:

The County must provide evidence of compliance that an FSP agreement is consistently entered into for each client served under the FSP service category. An appropriate corrective action would be for the County to provide all FSP agreements for FY 2024-25. If there are no FSP agreements for FY 2024-25, provide an explanation for why there are none and what steps will be taken to become compliant.
