<sup>3</sup> The ACA Expansion Adult – Undocumented aid group was categorized using aid codes M2 and L7. Individuals in this aid group are entitled to restricted-scope services, such as pregnancy-related services, emergency services, and LTC services.

<sup>4</sup> Individuals enrolled in LTC aid codes 13, 23, 53, and 63. Does not include individuals who may have used LTC services, but were not enrolled in a LTC aid code.

<sup>5</sup> As they are entitled to full-scope Medi-Cal benefits, individuals age 0-25 without satisfactory immigration status are dispersed throughout other aid categories.
