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ABSTRACT

This report provides summary data on Medi-Cal funded induced abortions performed during 2003 and 2004, and Medi-Cal expenditures for these procedures. The report is based on abortion claims received for services during calendar year 2003 or 2004, allowing a nine-month lag each year for delays in payments. The data are presented at both county and state levels.

Estimates of abortions for enrollees in County Organized Health Systems (COHS) and Health Care Plans (HCP) are included since encounter data are not yet reliable. However, for the encounters that have been reported, demographic information is displayed.

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HIGHLIGHTS

- The total estimated abortions provided to Medi-Cal beneficiaries were 90,953 in 2003 and 90,946 in 2004. This stable number from 2003 to 2004 is due to a five percent increase in the fee-for-service (FFS) ¹ abortions ² accompanied by a very minor decrease in County Organized Health Systems (COHS) abortions (-1%), and a six percent decrease in abortions provided to enrollees in Medi-Cal managed care plans.
- Medi-Cal funded a total of 50,240 FFS abortions in 2003 and paid an average of \$406 per procedure, totaling \$20,416,452 for these abortions.
- Medi-Cal funded a total of 52,551 FFS abortions in 2004 and paid an average of \$412 per procedure, totaling \$21,664,321 for these abortions.
- County Organized Health Systems reported 4,064 abortions in 2003 and 4,054 in 2004. Encounter reporting is incomplete and estimates were made to project the total expected abortions within the COHS systems. The estimated total for COHS 2003 abortions was 5,098 while the 2004 estimate was 5,065. Although completeness of reporting differs by county, the aggregate reported numbers appear to be about two-thirds complete.
- Medi-Cal funded managed care plans reported 26,851 abortions in 2003 and 26,663 in 2004. As with the COHS, managed care encounter reporting is incomplete and estimates were made of additional expected abortions. The projected total abortions provided to Medi-Cal beneficiaries in managed care plans were 35,615 in 2003 and 33,330 in 2004.
- During both 2003 and 2004 over one-third of Medi-Cal funded abortions were performed for women 20-24 years old. This is consistently the largest age group for Medi-Cal funded abortions, whether paid through FFS or managed care (MC) – which includes both COHS and other managed care plans.
- Race/ethnicity was not reported for many of the women receiving FFS funded abortions (45% in 2003, 47% in 2004). Conversely, in MC race/ethnicity was not reported in 13% of the 2003 abortions and 17% of the 2004 abortions.
- The “Families” aid category (which includes CalWORKS and medically needy families) dominated the aid groupings for Medi-Cal funded MC abortions, a reflection of the population in MC arrangements. In FFS Medi-Cal, the “Presumptive Eligibles” was the largest group of women receiving abortions (33%

in 2003, 36% in 2004), followed by the “Families” category at 25% in 2003 and 23% in 2004.

- In both FFS and MC the type of abortion procedure utilized was more commonly the dilation and curettage (D&C) which was used 73-78% of the time. This procedure also carried the lowest average cost.
- In FFS Medi-Cal, physician services comprised the greatest percentage of abortion expenditures (53% in 2003, 50% in 2004). The second largest component was clinics (35% in 2003, 40% in 2004). Together these two provider types account for nearly all the FFS Medi-Cal abortion expenditures.

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Data Qualifications

This report discusses induced abortions that occurred during calendar years 2003 or 2004 that were paid by Medi-Cal during the same calendar year or January through September of the following year. The 21-month payment window per calendar year was used to allow for delays in submitting or processing claims.

Information for enrollees in County Organized Health Systems or Health Care Plans, known as managed care, is included in this report but is known to be substantially underreported. Estimates were made of the expected additional abortions and the estimated totals are also reported.

Medi-Cal claims processed and paid through the fiscal intermediary are the basis for the fee-for-service component in this report. The incentive for complete reporting is great since fee-for-service providers must submit a claim to be reimbursed for their services. Encounter reports submitted by the COHS and HCPs form the basis for the managed care component of the report. Unlike fee-for-service claims, encounters are reported sporadically.

To estimate the underreported abortions in managed care, the abortion rate by age group was calculated for the fee-for-service female Medi-Cal population (after excluding aid categories such as Presumptive Eligibility, Minor Consent and Undocumented which are served solely via fee-for-service Medi-Cal) and then applied to the managed care female eligible population by age group.

Caution is advised when comparing with previous reports of Medi-Cal abortions for two reasons. One is the change in the estimation method for underreported abortions in managed care, and the other is that reports for previous years have grouped the COHS abortions with fee-for-service rather than managed care. At one time the COHS services were only in San Mateo and Santa Barbara counties, and their reported encounters were streamed into the dataset used for building the fee-for-service research file. At this time there are eight counties reporting as COHS, all with varying levels of completeness of encounter reporting. The sources for this report are actual fee-for-service claims, managed care encounters, and the Medi-Cal eligibility files, so the COHS are more appropriately displayed along with the other managed care plans.

Managed care abortions were estimated by finding age-specific fee-for-service abortion rates, after excluding aid categories such as Presumptive Eligibility, Undocumented and Minor Consent which are served solely via fee-for-service Medi-Cal, then applying those abortion rates to the corresponding managed care eligible population.

County Distributions of Medi-Cal Funded Induced Abortions

The following tables display the distribution of fee-for-service abortion services by county. Managed care encounter reports remain too sporadic to be useful at the county level. Individual county data do not necessarily reflect the same number and expenditure distributions that exist statewide.

Data provided in Tables 9, 10, 11, and 12 are distributed by county of eligibility; i.e., the county that appears on the Medi-Cal card of the beneficiary. It should be noted that this is not necessarily the county of residence at the time of service, since a beneficiary could have moved from one county to another, and her eligibility might have been transferred at the time the service was rendered. Data in these tables may also include services performed outside California for a Medi-Cal beneficiary.

Data provided in Table 13 are distributed by county of provider; i.e., county of occurrence.
