<sup>1</sup> For presentation purposes, in any instance for which age was unknown, a certified eligible was grouped in the Ages 21-64 cohort. The number of such instances was not statistically significant.

<sup>2</sup> The ACA Expansion Adult – Undocumented aid group was categorized using the aid codes M2 and L7. Individuals in this aid group are entitled to restricted-scope services, such as pregnancy-related services, emergency services, and LTC services.

<sup>3</sup> Individuals enrolled in LTC aid codes 13, 23, 53, and 63. Does not include individuals who may have used LTC services, but were not enrolled in an LTC aid code.

<sup>4</sup> As they are entitled to full-scope Medi-Cal benefits, most individuals age 0-25 without satisfactory immigration status are dispersed throughout other aid categories.
