

Mental Health Services Act (MHSA) Performance Review Report

FINDINGS:

Finding #1:

Plumas County did not explain how individuals, and, as applicable, their parents, caregivers, or other family members, will be linked to County mental health services, a primary care provider, or other mental health treatment and how the Prevention and Early Intervention, Access and Linkage Programs will follow up with the referral to support engagement for treatment in the adopted Fiscal Year (FY) 2023-26 Three-Year Program and Expenditure Plan (Plan) and FY 2023-24 Annual Update (Update). (California Code of Regulations, title 9, sections 3755(h)(4), 3755(h)(5)).

Recommendation #1:

The County must submit evidence of compliance for how individuals, and, as applicable, their parents, caregivers, or other family members, will be linked to County mental health services, a primary care provider, or other mental health treatment; and how the Program will follow up with the referral to support engagement in treatment.

Suggested Improvement

Department of Health Care Services recommends the county enhance clarity and navigability of documents/reports by including a table of contents (if applicable). Additionally, each distinct section of a report should be clearly marked with distinct headings to facilitate easy reference and ensure that stakeholders can quickly locate and review the specific information relevant to each program.
