Summary of Evidence	Individuals living at A Mother Theresa Care (Formerly Agape Cottage III) have limited opportunities for interaction in and with the broader community. A Mother Theresa Care employs practices that impede an individual's community access. Individuals are unable to go into the community unaccompanied. Doors are locked and individuals do not have keys. Doors are alarmed. A Mother Theresa Care does not plan activities in the community based on individuals' interests and preferences. Individuals have little opportunity to participate in community activities with or without their housemates/roommates.
Summary of Remediation Strategy	A Mother Theresa Care created a process to ensure individuals do not experience restrictions that are not based on their individual assessed needs. They intend to impose restrictions only if a person-centered assessment identifies health and safety needs. If the person-centered team defines a restriction, it is based on the assessed need, documented in the Individual Service Plan (ISP), and reviewed at least annually. A Mother Theresa Care intends to support individuals to participate in community activities as they please unless there is a documented health and safety concerns in their ISP. Staff, family, or friends will support individuals who have such a documented need to participate in community activities as described in their ISP. Individuals will be given a key to their front door unless there is an assessed need documented in their ISP. The gate outside is no longer locked. A Mother Theresa Care discontinued the use of chimes. Individualized interventions will be implemented for those who have been assessed to need monitoring for their health and safety. These interventions will be documented in the ISP and reviewed at least annually.
	A Mother Theresa Care intends to plan community activities based on individuals' interests and preferences. Individuals will be encouraged to speak with staff if they want or need assistance with planning activities in which they are interested. During regular monthly meetings, the administrator solicits input from individuals asking them what they would like to do. Individuals are invited to participate and have the option to decline. Individuals can choose to go with or without their housemates/roommates. They have the option of choosing with whom they would like to go. The administrator maintains a calendar of scheduled activities.
