

ARTICLE:

New Reimbursement Rates for Institutes of Mental Disease Services

Assembly Bill (AB) 360 (Statutes of 2005, Chapter 508) mandates that the Institutions for Mental Disease (IMD) rates of payment are based on the Medi-Cal rates in effect on July 31, 2004. AB 360 also mandates an annual increase of 6.5 percent to IMD rates beginning July 1, 2005 through June 30, 2008. Beginning July 1, 2008, the annual increase will be 4.7 percent.

Accordingly, effective retroactively to July 1, 2005, the IMD rates are increased by 6.5 percent.

AB 360 (2005) Assembly Bill 360 (Statutes of 2005, Chapter 508) mandates that Institutions for Mental Disease (IMD) rates of payment are based on the Medi-Cal rates in effect on July 31, 2004. In addition, AB 360 mandates an annual 6.5 percent increase to IMD rates beginning July 1, 2005, and continuing through June 30, 2008. Beginning July 1, 2008, the annual rate increase will be 4.7 percent.
