

Institutions for Mental Disease Rates

Assembly Bill 2645 (Statutes of 2010 Chapter 554) amended Welfare & Institutions Code § 5912 to mandate no increase to the IMD rates for 2010/11 and 2011/12. The 2009/10 IMD rates continue to remain in effect.

Effective July 1, 2009 these rates are:

Note1: The rates shown above for accommodation codes 11 and 12 include the Special Treatment Program (STP) supplement of \$5.72 per resident, per day.

Note 2: The rate reduction for leave of absence and bed hold for acute hospitalization is \$5.54 per diem for dates of service on or after August 1, 2009.
