

LEA Medi-Cal Billing Option Program
RMTS Implementation Advisory Group (IAG)
Meeting #28 Summary
June 6, 2017

On Tuesday, June 6th, the twenty-eighth RMTS Implementation Advisory Group (IAG) meeting took place in Sacramento. The following was accomplished during this meeting:

- Review of stakeholder feedback from two groups on the following topics:
 - One stakeholder noted a concern regarding transportation providers, who often have split shifts, and their participation in RMTS. The IAG briefly discussed the cost reporting process and noted that although transportation will be included in the new CRCS, the transportation providers will not be included in the RMTS direct service cost pool and will not receive moments.
 - One stakeholder noted that the link to the April 2017 IAG meeting summary was broken; the Department has fixed this link.
 - The IAG continues to review and discuss stakeholder feedback submitted via the [Stakeholder Feedback Tool](#), and encourages stakeholders to submit feedback. Stakeholder information submitted through the feedback tool is treated as confidential.
- The IAG reviewed the final draft versions of the two participant pool lists that will be submitted to CMS for approval and effective once the LEA Program is integrated into the RMTS.
- DHCS mentioned that they met via conference call with CMS on May 30th to discuss the draft CRCS and instructions. In order to complete the review of the cost report, CMS would like to review the Department's implementation plan.
 - The IAG will be conducting a final review of the draft LEA RMTS Implementation Guide (also known as the 'implementation plan'), which will then go to DHCS management for review, prior to CMS submission.
 - On the conference call, CMS indicated they had questions on the Department's March 2017 responses to the Requests for Additional Information (RAIs) and they would be sending the Department clarifying questions by mid-June.
- The IAG reviewed SPA 15-021 new practitioner qualifications, supervision requirements and prescription/referral/recommendation requirements, which will be included in the updated LEA Provider Manual upon SPA approval.
- The IAG reviewed a draft training presentation, which was prepared to inform LEAs on upcoming LEA Program implementation of RMTS. This training is focused on LEAs participating in the LEA BOP and not currently participating in SMAA, with limited or no RMTS experience. The IAG suggested edits to the presentation and will be reviewing a new draft of the training in July 2017. The Department continues to develop training materials for LEAs, which will be presented to the LEA community after CMS approves SPA 15-021.

The next RMTS IAG Meeting will be held on Tuesday, August 1, 2017.
