

AOT Annual Reporting

» Purpose

» In accordance with the Welfare & Institutions Code (W&I) 5348(d), the Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) is required to annually collect programmatic data outcomes for the required elements from participating AOT counties.

» DHCS annually reviews the data collection methodology and any limitations for the Laura's Law Legislative Report in order to enhance and further standardize the data collection process.

Outcome Evaluation Design


- » Informed by previous years' data collection
- » Navigation

 - » Responses are saved page by page
 - » Instructions provided throughout
 - » Branching questions determine the information requested

- » Corresponding question numbers listed alongside terms
- » Identified data collection format
- » Refined descriptions and examples

Assisted Outpatient Treatment (AOT) Data Dictionary					
Term	Statute	Question	Description	Data Collection Format	Examples
Type of Treatment	5348(d)(10)	1	All services included in court- mandated treatment plan and/or provided to an AOT individual for the duration of enrollment.	Select from treatment types listed	This may include, but is not limited to, case management, medication management, outreach support, housing support, life skills support, substance use disorder treatment, and rehabilitation, individual/group counseling, etc.

Reporting Standards

» Privacy and confidentiality

- » Privacy protocols in place by Survey Monkey
- » Aggregate level data reporting
- » DHCS Data De-identification Guidelines (DDG)
- » Multiple metrics and/or assessments may be utilized in fulfilling required outcomes
- » Counties must adhere to the AOT Data Dictionary 2022 for completion of the Outcome Evaluation

Reporting Standards Cont'd

Reporting Terminology	Timeframe		
Pre-enrollment	Not to exceed 12 months prior to entering program.		
During enrollment	The duration between court order and end of enrollment		
Post-enrollment	As available		
At the time of enrollment	Date of court order		
At the end of initial petition period	6 months (180 days) from date of court order		
At the time of discharge/end of enrollment	Date of "Completion" or "Termination" from AOT program


