

## TIME AND DISTANCE – CORRECTIVE ACTION PLAN CLOSURE AND RESPONSE TO ALTERNATE ACCESS STANDARD REQUEST

Dear Ms. Seleski:

On July 3, 2018, the Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) imposed a Corrective Action Plan (CAP) on Health Net for failing to ensure that all members have access to a primary care dentist (PCD) within the required time and distance standard (30 minutes or 10 miles) in accordance with DHCS Contract, Exhibit A, Attachment 8.E. The plan was found deficient in meeting the time and distance standards for both adult and pediatric PCDs in the following zip codes: 95641, 95690, and 93536.

Since June 4, 2018, Health Net has been providing DHCS with bi-weekly updates on the status of contracting efforts with additional PCDs within these zip codes. On September 6, 2018, the plan submitted the following alternate access standard (AAS) requests which have been **approved**.

Zipcode	City	PCD Type	AAS Request
95641	Isleton	Adult; Pediatric	35 minutes or 25 miles
95690	Walnut Grove	Adult; Pediatric	35 minutes or 15 miles

In addition, the plan submitted documentation substantiating that the required time and distance standard for zip code 93536 (Lancaster) has been met through additional provider contract(s) secured.

All items have been reviewed and this CAP is hereby closed.
