

SUBJECT: DATA REQUEST REQUIREMENTS FOR CHILD HEALTH DISABILITY

PREVENTION REPORT CONTAINED IN POLICY LETTER 10-013

## **PURPOSE:**

The purpose of this All Plan Letter (APL) is to update Medi-Cal managed care health plans (MCPs) on the reporting requirements contained in Policy Letter (PL) 10-013.<sup>1</sup>

## **BACKGROUND:**

In PL 10-013, the Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) requested that MCPs provide data related to the Children's Health and Disability Program (CHDP). This data was used to assist DHCS in the preparation of a legislative report on pediatric preventive services, as required by Welfare and Institutions Code Section 14138.5.

## **REQUIREMENT:**

It was determined by the Legislative Counsel that pursuant to Assembly Bill 1585 (Chapter 7, Statutes of 2010), DHCS is no longer required to submit the legislative report pursuant to Welfare and Institutions Code Section 14138.5. As a result, MCPs are no longer required to provide the requested data specified in PL 10-013.<sup>2</sup>
