

Preliminary Subpoena Fee Schedule

<p>Subpoenas \$15.00 witness fee required</p> <p>NOTE: A witness is entitled to \$35 plus 20 cents a mile, for miles actually travelled both going and coming.</p>	<p>A party may subpoena a witness to personally testify at a deposition or trial, or request the production of records by delivering a subpoena to the Department's Agent for Service of Process.</p>
<p>Personal Appearance (Civil or Federal) \$275.00 deposit</p>	<p>Personal appearance of a witness requires one copy of the subpoena and a deposit at the time of service. (Gov. Code, § 68097.2.)</p>
<p>Federal Records Subpoenas (No is fee required)</p>	<p>NOTE: Federal Subpoenas Must Be Hand-Served to the Department for proper Service of Process.</p>
<p>Authorizations \$25.00</p>	<p>A request, for information by a representative. If no check is provided, or if check amount differs, the Department will remit item(s) to accounting for processing.</p>
<p>Worker's Compensation Subpoenas \$15.00 witness fee required</p> <p>NOTE: Does not require a Notice to Consumer.</p>	<p>A worker's compensation subpoena should include an authorization, when signed by the issuing county court clerk.</p>
<p>Request for Access (No fee is required)</p>	<p>An individual and/or patient requesting their own information.</p>
<p>Search Warrant and Cease and Desist Subpoena Records (No fee is required)</p>	
<p>When Is A Consumer Notice Not Required?</p>	<p>When a subpoena has been signed by a Judge.</p>
