Federal Records Subpoenas (No is fee required)	NOTE: Federal Subpoenas Must Be Hand- Served to the Department for proper Service of Process.
Authorizations \$25.00	A request, for information by a representative. If no check is provided, or if check amount differs, the Department will remit item(s) to accounting for processing.
Worker's Compensation Subpoenas \$15.00 witness fee required NOTE: Does not require a Notice to Consumer.	A worker's compensation subpoena should include an authorization, when signed by the issuing county court court's clerk.
Request for Access (No fee is required)	An individual and/or patient requesting their own information.
Search Warrant and Cease and Desist Subpoena Records (No fee is required)	
When Is A Consumer Notice Not Required?	When a subpoena has been signed by a Judge.
