## THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH CARE SERVICES PROPOSES TO SUBMIT A STATE PLAN AMENDMENT TO PROVIDE SCHOOL-BASED VISION CARE SERVICES TO STUDENTS WITHIN THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

This notice is to provide information of public interest with respect to the proposed State Plan Amendment (SPA) 19-0009 for the Local Educational Agency (LEA) Medi-Cal Billing Option Program. Proposed SPA 19-0009 will provide comprehensive vision services to Medi-Cal eligible students. SPA 19-0009 seeks to improve the health of lowincome children by increasing their access to needed vision services by providing comprehensive eye exams, corrective lenses, and frames (if medically necessary) at school sites. The effective date for the proposed SPA is January 1, 2019.

SPA 19-0009 seeks to add medically necessary comprehensive eye exams, corrective lenses, and frames. These medically necessary services, will be considered as direct medical services covered by the LEA Medi-Cal Billing Option Program. As part of the SPA process, the Department of Health Care Services will establish a billing methodology and program policy to allow LEA providers to seek Federal Financial Participation for the new vision services.

DHCS estimates that the overall budgetary impact could result in an aggregate increase in expenditure of \$6.2 million and subject to change because participation in the LEA Program is voluntary.

The proposed SPA is subject to approval by the Federal Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS).
