This action by the Department of Health Care Services (Department) eliminates the requirement that Mental Health Rehabilitation Centers (MHRCs), that also provide Adult Residential Treatment Services, obtain and maintain Social Rehabilitation Program (SRP) certification in addition to their MHRC licenses, because SRP certification is duplicative of MHRC licensing requirements and, therefore, unnecessarily burdensome on MHRCs to obtain and maintain and on the Department to regulate.

OAL approves this regulatory action pursuant to section 11349.3 of the Government Code. This regulatory action becomes effective on 1/1/2021.

TITLE 9. REHABILITATIVE AND DEVELOPMENTAL SERVICES DIVISION 1. DEPARTMENT OF MENTAL HEALTH Chapter 11. MEDI-CAL SPECIALTY MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES

Amend Section 1840.332 to read:

§ 1840.332. Adult Residential Treatment Services Contact and Site Provider Requirements.

- (a) <u>Programs that provide</u> Adult Residential Treatment Services shall have a clearly established certified <u>or licensed</u> site for services, although all services need not be delivered at that site. Services shall not be claimable unless there is face-to-face contact between the beneficiary and a treatment staff person of the facility on the day of service and the beneficiary has been admitted to the program.
- (b) Programs that provide Adult Residential Treatment Services, except Mental

 Health Rehabilitation Centers as defined in Section 782.34, Chapter 3.5, Division 1, of

 Title 9, must-shall be certified as a Social Rehabilitation Program by the Department as
 either a Transitional Residential Treatment Program or a Long Term Residential

 Treatment Program in accordance with Chapter 3, Division 1, of Title 9. Facility capacity

 must be limited to a maximum of 16 beds.
- (c) In addition to Social Rehabilitation Program certification, pPrograms which that provide Adult Residential Treatment Services must shall be licensed as a Social Rehabilitation Facility or Community Care Facility by the State Department of Social Services in accordance with Chapters 1 and 2, Division 6, of Title 22 or authorized to operate as a Mental Health Rehabilitation Center by the Department in accordance with Chapter 3.5, Division 1, of Title 9, beginning with Section 51000-781.00.
- (d) Facility capacity for programs that provide Adult Residential Treatment Services shall be limited to a maximum of 16 beds.
