 50195. Period of Eligibility.

(a) The period of eligibility for Medi-Cal for persons eligible for AFDC or SSI/SSP shall begin with the date specified in Section 50701 50193 (a) and (b), and shall continue through each successive month during which the person is determined to be eligible.

(b) The period of eligibility for Medi-Cal for persons eligible as Other PA recipients shall begin with the date specified in Section <u>50701-50193</u> (c), and shall continue through each successive month during which the person meets all eligibility requirements of the appropriate Other PA category.

(c) The period of eligibility for Medi-Cal for persons eligible as MN or MI, except as specified in (d), shall begin with the date specified in Section 50701–<u>50193</u> (c), and shall continue through each successive month during which the beneficiary meets the appropriate basic program requirements in Article 5 of this chapter and all of the following conditions:

(c)(1) - (3) - No changes

(d) The period of eligibility for Medi-Cal for a child applying on his or her own behalf in accordance with Section 50147.1 (a) shall begin with the date specified in Section 50701 50193 (c), and shall continue through each successive month during which the child meets both of the following conditions:
