

TIP THREE: REPORTING DIAGNOSIS CODES

Tip Three provides examples for reporting the diagnoses required by the Client and Service Information (CSI) system in the following data fields within the Service record:

S-09.0 Principal Mental Health Diagnosis, S-10.0 Secondary Mental Health Diagnosis, S-11.0 Additional Mental or Physical Health Diagnosis, S-34.0 General Medical Condition Summary Codes, S-37.0 Substance Abuse / Dependence, and S-38.0 Substance Abuse / Dependence Diagnosis.

International Classification of Diseases 10th Edition (ICD-10) code is required.

The Principal and Secondary Mental Health Diagnoses must be diagnoses for which mental health services are provided. The S-09.0 Principal Mental Health Diagnosis should reflect the diagnosis that is the primary focus of attention or treatment for mental health services. The S-10.0 Secondary Mental Health Diagnosis should reflect the diagnosis that is the secondary focus of attention or treatment for mental health services.

Up to three diagnoses are allowed in the data field S-11.0 Additional Mental or Physical Health Diagnosis. They may include mental, substance use, developmental disorders, or physical health disorders. If there are more than three diagnoses available to be reported, list the three most important.

Up to three General Medical Condition (GMC) Summary Codes from the list of general medical conditions provided are allowed in the S-34.0 General Medical Condition Summary Code field.

Identify whether or not the client has a substance abuse/dependence issue in the S-37.0 Substance Abuse/Dependence field. If the client does have a substance abuse/dependence issue, then report the substance abuse/dependence diagnosis in the S-38.0 Substance Abuse/Dependence Diagnosis field.

The following pages present examples of both valid and invalid diagnosis code reporting.

Note: The Principal and Secondary Mental Health Diagnoses are reported. The record also contains 3 additional Mental or Physical Health Diagnoses, a GMC Summary Code, Substance Abuse/Dependence issue, and a Substance Abuse/Dependence Diagnosis.

Note: The Principal Mental Health Diagnosis is reported. The Secondary Mental Health Diagnosis is 9999999 (Diagnosis Unknown/Deferred). The record also contains 1 additional Mental or Physical Health Diagnosis, a GMC Summary Code, a Substance Abuse/Dependence issue is coded 'U' (Unknown) and Substance Abuse/Dependence Diagnosis is 9999999 (Unknown/Deferred Diagnosis).

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Note: The Principal Mental Health Diagnosis is reported. There are no Secondary Mental Health Diagnosis and no additional Mental or Physical Health Diagnoses, a GMC Summary Code, no Substance Abuse/Dependence issue, and Substance Abuse/Dependence Diagnosis is 0000000 (No Diagnosis).

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Note: The Principal Mental Health Diagnosis is 9999999 (Unknown/Deferred Diagnosis). There are no Secondary Mental Health Diagnosis and no additional Mental or Physical Health Diagnoses, a GMC Summary Code, a Substance Abuse/Dependence issue, and Substance Abuse/Dependence Diagnosis is 9999999 (Diagnosis Unknown/Deferred).

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Note: The Principal Mental Health Diagnosis is reported. There are no Secondary Mental Health Diagnosis and 2 additional Mental or Physical Health Diagnoses, a GMC Summary Code, a Substance Abuse / Dependence issue is coded 'Z' (Not Reported), and Substance Abuse/Dependence Diagnosis is 0000000 (No Diagnosis).

Note: Principal and Secondary Diagnoses must be within the mental, behavioral and neurodevelopmental disorders range (F01-99). The GMC Summary Code cannot be blank.

Note: If there are two diagnoses within the mental, behavioral and neurodevelopmental disorders range (F01-99), they must be placed in the Principal and Secondary Mental Health Diagnosis fields. Although the Substance Abuse/Dependence is 'N' (No, the client does not have a substance abuse/dependent issue), the record contains a reportable Substance Abuse/Dependence Diagnosis.

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Note: If there is only one diagnosis within the mental, behavioral and neurodevelopmental disorders range (F01-99), it must be placed in the Principal Mental Health Diagnosis field. Although the Substance Abuse/Dependence is 'Y', the Substance Abuse/Dependence Diagnosis is 0000000 (No Diagnosis).

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Note: If there is a diagnosis within the mental, behavioral and neurodevelopmental disorders range (F01-99), it must be placed in the Principal Mental Health Diagnosis field. Although the Substance Abuse / Dependence is coded 'U' (Unknown), the record contains a reportable Substance Abuse/Dependence Diagnosis.

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Note: Principal Mental Health Diagnosis must be within the mental, behavioral and neurodevelopmental disorders range (F01-99). Although the Substance Abuse/Dependence is coded 'Z' (Not Reported), the record contains a reportable Substance Abuse/Dependence Diagnosis. The GMC Summary code should be a valid code from the list of general medical conditions provided.
