The Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) investigated InnovAge Crenshaw Program of All-Inclusive Care for the Elderly (PACE) based upon a complaint DHCS received on June 18, 2025. The complaint alleged the following regarding [REDACTED].

- PO declined placement request for the participant to a non-contracted out-of-network facility preferred by the complainant.

DHCS is in receipt of InnovAge Crenshaw PACE's response emails and medical record review throughout the investigation. After reviewing the relevant facts and documentation DHCS is unable to substantiate the concern raised by the complainant.
