Sections 9795 through 9886

This letter provides notification that the Office of Administrative Law approved the regulatory action pursuant to section 11349.3 of the Government Code which amended CCR, Title 9, Division 4, Chapter 3, Programs for Drug Impaired Drivers. This regulatory action becomes effective on April 21, 2012. However, the Department of Alcohol and Drug Programs (ADP) is granting a 90-day grace period prior to citing deficiencies related to the newly amended regulations. Analysts will begin citing deficiencies on or after July 20, 2012 in adherence to the new regulations.

In conjunction with these amendments, ADP is offering two training sessions to assist programs and affected parties with understanding and implementation of the regulatory changes. The attached flyer provides training dates and locations.
