Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) Tribal and Designees of Indian Health Programs Notice Addendum #2

PURPOSE

To provide notice of a delay in the effective date for State Plan Amendment (SPA) 22-0014. The new effective date is March 14, 2023.

BACKGROUND

The <u>Tribal and Designees notice released on November 22, 2022</u> for SPA 22-0014 proposed an effective date of January 1, 2023, to permanently continue synchronous audio-only and asynchronous modalities and allow for reimbursement of services delivered by Associate Clinical Social Worker (ASW) or Associate Marriage Family Therapist (AMFT) when billed under the license of a behavioral health practitioner.

SUMMARY OF PROPOSED CHANGES

DHCS is establishing a new effective date for SPA 22-0014 of March 14, 2023.

IMPACT TO TRIBAL HEALTH PROGRAMS

DHCS does not anticipate an impact to Tribal Health Programs as a result of the delay in the effective date for SPA 22-0014 because existing public health emergency (PHE) flexibilities will remain in place until this SPA is approved.

IMPACT TO FEDERALLY QUALIFIED HEALTH CENTERS

DHCS does not anticipate an impact to FQHCs as a result of the delay in the effective date for SPA 22-0014 because existing PHE flexibilities will remain in place until this SPA is approved.

IMPACT TO INDIAN MEDI-CAL BENEFICIARIES

DHCS does not anticipate an impact to Indian Medi-Cal beneficiaries as a result of the delay in the effective date for SPA 22-0014 because existing PHE flexibilities will remain in place until this SPA is approved.
