

PROPOSED STATE PLAN AMENDMENT TO UPDATE THE MEDI-CAL REIMBURSEMENT METHODOLOGY FOR STATE FISCAL YEAR (SFY) 2025-26 DIAGNOSIS RELATED GROUP (DRG) PAYMENTS

This notice is to provide information of public interest about a proposed State Plan Amendment (SPA) by the Department of Health Care Services (DHCS). Proposed SPA #25-0022 will make changes to the DRG program for general acute care inpatient hospital services provided by:

- 1. Private hospitals and non-designated public hospitals in California,
- 2. Out-of-state (border and non-border) hospitals, and
- 3. Medicare-designated critical access hospitals (See Cal. Welf. & Inst. Code §14105.28).

Proposed SPA #25-0022 will update Appendix 6 to Attachment 4-19A, page 3. These modifications include:

 Adding gene therapy carve-out codes J3394 Lovotibeglogene autotemcel (Lyfgenia) and J3392 Exagamglogene autotemcel (Casgevy) to the Separately Payable Services, Devices, and Supplies list on the Appendix 6 to Attachment 4.19-A.

DHCS estimates that the annual aggregate expenditures for acute inpatient hospital services will be budget neutral. However, the impact to individual hospitals varies by actual utilization and casemix.

The effective date of the proposed SPA is July 1, 2025. All proposed SPAs are subject to approval by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS).
