

PROPOSED STATE PLAN AMENDMENT TO TRANSITION THE INTERMEDIATE CARE FACILITIES FOR THE DEVELOPMENTALLY DISABLED – CONTINOUS NURSING BENEFIT/SETTING INTO THE MEDICAID STATE PLAN

This notice is to provide information of public interest about a proposed State Plan Amendment (SPA) by the Department of Health Care Services (DHCS). The proposed SPA will transition the Intermediate Care Facilities for the Developmentally Disabled – Continuous Nursing (ICF/DD-CN) benefit/setting from the 1915(c) Home and Community-Based Alternatives (HCBA) waiver to the Medicaid State Plan as a Long-Term Care (LTC) benefit/setting. DHCS requests input from beneficiaries, providers, and other interested stakeholders concerning proposed SPA #25-0026, which is attached.

DHCS estimates that the annual aggregate Medi-Cal expenditures for adding the ICF/DD-CN benefit/setting will increase by approximately \$443,000.

The effective date of the proposed SPA is November 1, 2025. All proposed SPAs are subject to approval by the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS).

Public Review and Comments

The proposed changes included in draft SPA #25-0026 are enclosed in this notice for public comment. DHCS is requesting stakeholder input on the impact, if any, on access to services as a result of the proposed action.
