

# **Newly Enrolled in May 2023**









#### **Data Definitions and Notes:**

- Application counts are <u>rolling</u> across each month since Medi-Cal application timelines are 45-days for non-disability applications and 90-days for disability applications. The four metrics <u>will not add up</u> to the monthly "Applications Received by Submission Pathways" since the counts will include retroactive months of determination and applications over 45-day or 90-day due to good cause and/or county working with the Medi-Cal applicant
- 1 Newly Enrolled: Individuals with no prior history of Medi-Cal coverage for the reporting month.
- <sup>2</sup> Applications in Process: Applications currently being reviewed by county social services agencies in the reporting month.
- 3 Eligible for Coverage: Individual is determined eligible for Medi-Cal or Children's Health Insurance Program in the reporting month.
- 4 Ineligible for Coverage: Individual is determined ineligible for Medi-Cal or Children's Health Insurance Program in the reporting month.
- The Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) publishes a <u>public dataset</u> of monthly counts of Notice of Inaction (NOI) sent to Medi-Cal applicants whose pending application is reaching 45 days due to an improper delay by the county that is processing the application. A NOI is not issued when the application delay is due to the applicant failing to provide requested information to the county, which is considered a proper delay. The monthly counts include the total Medi-Cal and Covered California applications received and the total number/percentage of Medi-Cal applications pending 45 days, including both proper and improper application processing delays.


#### **Data Definitions and Notes:**

- 1 Renewed (Via Ex parte Process) is one of the most critical components of the Medi-Cal determination process, as it allows redeterminations to process automatically once all information passes through the Federal and State databases for verification or using available information to the county without the need to contact the beneficiary. Beneficiaries are who are renewed via ex parte have their Medi-Cal cases renewed for another year.
- 2 Valid Disensellments: Medi-Cal members who were validly discontinued during the continuous coverage period due to moving out of state, death, or voluntary withdrawal requesting discontinuance.
- 3 Maintained in Coverage under Continuous Coverage Protections: Total number of individuals not renewed via exparte, but maintained in coverage due to the continuous coverage period.
