## **PURPOSE**

This bulletin conveys additional information regarding the reduction in appropriations of State General Funds (SGF) for Non Drug Medi-Cal Perinatal Services, (Perinatal Ongoing and Women and Children Residential Treatment Services\* [WCRTS]). Included in this bulletin is an individual county form reflecting the net amount allocated for perinatal programs in Fiscal Year (FY) 2001-02. We are requesting that this form be used to identify the amount of the reduction and to justify any reduction in residential services.

#### **DISCUSSION**

As stated in ADP Bulletin 01-22, the FY 2001-02 SGF appropriation for Non-DMC Perinatal services was reduced by \$1 million.

Due to the difficulties in establishing residential capacity, counties should give funding priority to residential services. If your county plans to reduce funding for any perinatal residential service, then complete and return the attached justification form by November 21, 2001. The Department will review the information submitted for approval. To maintain prior year levels of service (i.e., array of services and number of clients served), a county may use other funding sources to supplement this year's reduction (e.g., prior year savings).
