

STATE PLAN AMENDMENT (SPA) 22-0004

The Center for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) approved State Plan Amendment (SPA) 22-0004 on March 24, 2023, which added or extended COVID-19 coverage from previously approved Disaster Relief SPAs through the end of the American Rescue Plan Act (ARP) period on September 30, 2024. SPA 22-0004 added or extended costsharing assurances for the treatment and prevention of COVID-19, COVID-19 tests, counseling-only visits for COVID-19 vaccines, and reimbursement for eligible pharmacies administering COVID-19 tests as a covered benefit. This public notice states that the reimbursement methodologies established by SPA 22-0004 will continue from the end of the Public Health Emergency (PHE) on May 11, 2023, through the end of the ARP period on September 30, 2024.

Through SPA 22-0004, DHCS extended the payment methodologies, including the enhanced reimbursement rates (where applicable), established until the end of the PHE by SPAs 20-0024, 20-0040, 21-0016, 21-0020, 22-0067, and 22-0067-A from the first day after the federal PHE until the end of the ARP period.
