ANNOUNCEMENT: CALIFORNIA TO DISCUSS TOPLINE MEDI-CAL RENEWAL DATA

SACRAMENTO – On July 20, 2023, the Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) will host a briefing on June 2023 Medi-Cal eligibility redetermination data.

DHCS will discuss preliminary data for June 2023 Medi-Cal renewals, the first month of California's redeterminations since the end of the federal continuous coverage requirement on March 31. These data will include initial disenrollments from Medi-Cal eligibility renewals that occurred on July 1. Annual renewals will continue monthly, with the last eligibility renewal under the continuous coverage requirement occurring in May 2024, followed by a return to the normal annual renewal process.

BACKGROUND: In March 2020, at the beginning of the COVID-19 public health emergency, the federal government paused all Medi-Cal eligibility renewals. However, that pause ended on March 31, 2023, as did the continuous coverage requirement. Medi-Cal renewals resumed in April 2023. Between June 2023 and May 2024, more than 13 million Medi-Cal members will have their eligibility renewed.
