State Level Associations / Stakeholder Groups	 Identify key state level associations and stakeholder groups that represent the criminal justice population (e.g., <u>DHCS' Justice-Involved Reentry Initiative</u>, <u>CCJBH</u>, <u>CPOC</u>, <u>HARP</u>, and <u>CCHCS</u>) Schedule meetings to provide an overview of DMC-ODS and discuss opportunities to engage criminal justice partners at the local level to address the needs of the population.
County Level Stakeholder Groups	 Identify key county-level stakeholder groups that represent the criminal justice population. Schedule local meetings with correctional facilities in your jurisdiction to provide an overview of DMC-ODS and discuss opportunities to enhance the system of care available to the criminal justice population.
Other DMC-ODS Counties with Innovative Practices	 Review approved <u>DMC-ODS Implementation Plans</u> to identify other counties that are implementing innovative practices. Reach out to leaders in those counties to see if they would be available and willing to present on their local efforts and discuss best practices and lessons learned from their experience. Schedule a webinar / convening to highlight county efforts. Review the <u>County Readiness Status Dashboard</u> on the DHCS JI webpage to stay up-to-date on the list of counties approved to go-live with pre-release services and BH Links.
