# Placer Co. Whole Person Care

Pilot was developed:

1. In response to local priorities
2. In collaboration with local stakeholders
3. Understanding local strengths and limitations



# Placer WPC Target Population

- Approximately 150 residents (at any one time) of Placer County who are Medi-Cal members
- We expect to serve approximately 450 unique individuals over the course of the pilot
- Priority “scoring system” for membership:
  1. Experiencing homelessness (100 points)
  2. More than 6 hospital visits in the last year (50 points)
  3. On probation or scheduled for release from jail (20 points)
  4. Serious Mental Illness and/or Substance Use Disorder (15 points)
  5. Two or more chronic health conditions (10 points)

- Member Engagement
