QIP POLICY LETTER 24-008

TO: ALL QIP ENTITIES

SUBJECT: QIP PY6 and PY7 Audit Update

PURPOSE:

This QIP Policy Letter (QPL) informs QIP entities on Performance Measure Validation (PMV) in PY 6 and PY 7.

BACKGROUND:

On July 1, 2017, the Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) implemented a managed care directed payment program, the Quality Incentive Pool (QIP) program. QIP advances the state's goal of enhancing quality in DHCS programs by incentivizing Designated Public Hospital (DPHs) and District and Municipal Public Hospitals (DMPHs) to expand Medi-Cal members' access to preventive services, screenings, and wellness programs. Annual QIP payments to public hospitals worth over \$1 billion are based on meeting important clinical quality benchmarks which is verified by an external data auditor, Health Services Advisory Group (HSAG), certified by the National Committee for Quality Assurance (NCQA), to ensure accuracy and completeness of the reported data and to provide technical support to participating public hospitals to improve data processes for future reporting.

POLICY:

In PY6, spanning from January 1, 2023, through December 31, 2023, and in PY7, which spans from January 1, 2024, through December 31, 2024, DHCS will require that fifty percent of QIP participating entities undergo PMV audit activities for PY6 data and the remaining fifty percent undergo PMV audit activities for PY7 data. The reason for this is a fixed DHCS budget for auditing activities which does not cover the cost of auditing of PY6 and PY7 data for all hospitals. PMV activities are designed to assess the accuracy of performance measures data reported by each QIP entity, to determine the extent to which reported data and calculations align with the QIP measure specifications and reporting requirements. DHCS will review data submissions, according to usual reporting process, for all hospitals regardless of the above PMV audit changes.
