#### **Program Guidance**

- >> Health Care Program for Children in Foster Care (HCPCFC) is a California Department of Social Services (CDSS) program, in which Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) and CDSS partner to administer, via an interagency agreement. Program guidelines are established by CDSS, DHCS, and statutory authority.
- In large part, references to regulation, letters, and notices within this training will be used in the place of the actual text. This approach is intended to support access to the most up-to-date information available regarding the given subject.
