Action Items:

- Members suggested demographic measures included in the forthcoming dashboard specify SAR level
 - Response: DHCS will take this into consideration, but the initial priority is to distinguish between classic CCS and WCM counties
- Members asked how DHCS will prioritize measure selection if the vote results in more than 3-5 Tier 1 measures
 - Response: DHCS will track the voting results for each individual measure and will take the percentage of "yes" votes into account when prioritizing measures for selection
