The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) is approving your request to amend the California Assisted Living Waiver that serves persons aged or disabled, 21 years or older. The CMS Control Number for this amendment is CA-0431.R04.02. Please use this number in future correspondence relevant to this waiver action.

With this amendment, the state is increasing the number of participants served in waiver year one. The effective date of the amendment is October 1, 2024. The waiver continues to be costneutral. The average per capita cost of waiver services estimates (Appendix J.1) have been approved.

This approval is subject to your agreement to serve no more individuals than the total number of unduplicated participants indicated in Appendix J.2 of the waiver. If the state wishes to serve more individuals or make any other alterations to this waiver, an amendment must be submitted for approval.

It is important to note that CMS approval of this waiver amendment solely addresses the state's compliance with the applicable Medicaid authorities. CMS approval does not address the state's independent and separate obligations under federal laws including, but not limited to, the Americans with Disabilities Act, Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act, or the Supreme Court's Olmstead decision. Guidance from the Department of Justice concerning compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act and the Olmstead decision is available at http://www.ada.gov/olmstead/q&a olmstead.htm.

CMS reminds the state that the state must have an approved spending plan in order to use the money realized from section 9817 of the American Rescue Plan (ARP). Approval of this action does not constitute approval of the state's spending plan.
