



# Incident Report Priority Levels

## Level 1 (Do not send to ALW)

### Low Priority

- Waiver Participant fall / behavior episode without injury.
- Waiver Participant self-determination to visit the emergency room.
- Waiver Participant remains out of facility over twenty-four hours; and no apparent injury or outside agency intervention.
- Waiver Participant transferred to hospice services.
- Waiver Participant death, that is expected and occurs outside the facility.

## Level 2

### Moderate Priority

- Waiver Participant falls with injury.
- Waiver Participant accidents and/or injuries with transfer to the emergency room or primary care physician and hospitalized.
- Waiver Participant aggressive act to self (including the over consumption of alcohol) or others with injury.
- ANY report of suicidal ideation or attempt..
- Change of condition requiring extensive hospitalization; re-location; or extensive revision of the ISP.
- The use of an AED or other CPR measures.

## Level 3

### High Priority

- Events reportable under Title 22 87651 (Epidemic outbreak, poisoning, fire, property damage or a major accident or incident that affected the health or welfare of the Waiver Participant or others in the facility or public housing site.);
- ALL suspected reports of abuse or neglect of any type;
- ALL reports of violation of Waiver Participant rights.
- ALL CASES OF COMMUNICABLE DISEASE;
- ANY violation of HIPPA;
- ALL RCFE Community Care Licensing sanctions.
- ANY unexpected deaths while residing at the RCFE.
