SUPERIOR SYSTEMS WAIVER RENEWAL

Dear Ms. Young:

The Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) is submitting its Superior Systems Waiver (SSW) Renewal request for your review and approval. This comprehensive SSW Renewal request describes Medi-Cal fee-for-service (FFS) utilization management in California hospitals for inpatient hospital stays. DHCS seeks approval of the SSW Renewal effective October 1, 2024, through September 30, 2029.

The purpose of the SSW is to allow California to effectively manage and control unnecessary and excessive utilization of Medi-Cal FFS acute inpatient services. Under the authority of the SSW, California achieves this goal by employing a thorough and thoughtful utilization review (UR) plan that best meets the needs of distinct hospital types in California. The Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) informed DHCS on November 8, 2023, that tribal notification for this SSW Renewal was not necessary. CMS also informed DHCS on November 28, 2023, that the SSW Renewal is not subject to federal public notice requirements.
