

New Law Gives

Former Foster Youth FREE Health Care until Age 26!



Thanks to the Affordable Care Act, you get FREE Medi-Cal coverage in California if you were in foster care in any state on your 18th birthday.

Be sure to say you are a former foster youth when you go to sign up!

Do I Qualify?

- Were you in foster care in ANY state on your 18th birthday?
- Do you live in California now?
- And are you younger than 26?

Then, YES, you qualify! Sign up today!

What do you need when you sign up?

3 reasons you should sign up for Medi-Cal for former foster youth:

STATE ON YOUR 18TH BIRTHDAY?

Bring your proof of residency to your local county services office when signing up for Medi-Cal. One of these items will work:

- California I.D. card or Driver's License
- Utility bill in your name
- Vehicle registration in your name

If you don't have these items, don't worry! Your local county services office can help.

Apply through the County by:

phone, fax, mail or in person.

Where can you sign up?

At your county Human Services or Social Services office: www.dhcs.ca.gov/services/medi-cal/Pages/CountyOffices.aspx

- **It's FREE:** You pay \$0 for health care. You get to save your money for school, rent, food, and other things you need.
- 2 No new application to fill out each year: You sign up for Medi-Cal one time and stay covered until your 26th birthday.
- **3 More choices:** You can go to any doctor, clinic, therapist, or hospital that takes Medi-Cal.

Applicants are not required to complete a full application or provide any additional information beyond what is required on the Application for Medi-Cal for Former Foster Care Children (MC 250A) Form. No income or asset test.
