

SUBJECT: County Administrative Expense Allocation and Payment Letters

The purpose of this letter is to provide notice of a change to the delivery system of the county allocation and payment letters for Medi-Cal administration costs.

Currently, each county receives a letter mailed to the director of the human services agency. The letters detail the allocation and payment information specific to the county. The process can take up to a week to get the letter from DHCS to the county director and the director must then share the letter with appropriate county staff, thus creating an additional delays.

Effective immediately, all allocation and payment letters will be sent via electronic mail to the director of the county and one additional representative. Hardcopies of the letters will no longer be mailed.

This is an effort to expedite delivery of information to the appropriate county representatives as quickly as possible. Please expect the payment letters for the Fiscal Year 2014/15 second quarter to be sent electronically to the designated county representatives near the end of December 2014.
