SUBJECT: RAMOS V. MYERS AID PAID PENDING LISTINGS

A request was made by members of the County Welfare Directors Association, Medical Care Committee, that the Medi-Cal Eligibility Branch (MEB) notify counties when a beneficiary is placed in Aid Paid Pending a Ramos v. Myers state hearing. This is to notify you that MEB has requested a MEDS change which, when implemented, will produce a county worker alert identifying such individuals.

Staff processing Ramos v. Myers cases should refer to these alerts to determine whether the individual is receiving Aid Paid Pending prior to processing an application. MEB has also requested that the MEDS Eligibility Status Code be changed to "007" on MEDS for those months the beneficiary received Ramos v. Myers Aid Paid Pending Medi-Cal cards.

We anticipate a completion date of March 1987 month of eligibility. Please watch the change cycle letters for further information regarding implementation of these enhancements. If you have any questions or suggestions, please call Frances Schurer at (916) 445-1799.
