The Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) is providing notification to Local Educational Agencies (LEAs) currently enrolled in the LEA Medi-Cal Billing Option Program that DHCS's Provider Enrollment Division (PED) has updated the enrollment rules effective for all Ordering, Referring and Prescribing (ORP) application packages received on or after March 20, 2018.

The effective date of enrollment for an approved DHCS 6219 form or equivalent PAVE e-Form shall be **one year prior to the date** DHCS received the complete application package, except:

- If DHCS receives the application package, but finds that the licenses, certificates
  and/or other approval to provide health care of the applicant were obtained at a
  date later than one year prior to the date when DHCS received the application for
  enrollment, the effective date of the notice shall be the date the applicant
  obtained all necessary licenses, certificates and/or other approval to provide
  health care.
- If an applicant fails to resubmit a complete application package within 60 days
  from the date that the notice of deficiency is sent to the applicant pursuant to W&I
  Code, Section 14043.26(h), then DHCS treats any subsequent resubmission of
  an application package as a new application received, and the effective date of
  the application will be one year prior to the date DHCS received the new
  application package.
