- Transition to MOVEit Server
 - LEAs and third party billing vendors who are authorized to receive LEA Medi-Cal Billing Option Program beneficiary Medi-Cal eligibility information via a data tape match are notified that the Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) Enterprise Innovation Technology Services (EITS) recently upgraded to Windows 10, and EITS will no longer be able to support Windows 7. Due to this change, the EITS Production Support Unit (PSU) is replacing the PGP protection encryption software with secure MOVEit Server.
 - SNFD is requesting that those LEAs and third party billing vendors who are authorized to receive LEA Medi-Cal Billing Option Program beneficiary Medi-Cal information via a data tape match notify Cheryl Ward at <u>Cheryl.Ward@dhcs.ca.gov</u> by COB August 28, 2017.
 - Once DHCS is notified, you will be provided with the information necessary to ensure a successful transition to access MOVEit.
 - Note that if a third party billing vendor represents multiple LEAs, DHCS only needs notification from the third party billing vendor who is authorized to receive LEA Medi-Cal Billing Option Program beneficiary information via a data tape match, and not from the individual LEAs that the billing vendor represents.
 - Note that those who are already using the MOVEit Server for the School Based Medi-Cal Administrative Activities (SMAA) Program will still need to notify DHCS if they are going to use the MOVEit Server for the LEA Medi-Cal Billing Option Program.

Note that DHCS EITS will be migrating all LEA third party vendors to MOVEit, including those that are currently not using PGP. This will ensure that the LEA process is consistent and processed in a timely manner.
