PURPOSE

This bulletin is to reiterate that the Department of Alcohol and Drug Programs (ADP) may require the reporting of private-pay/non-publicly assisted client data to the California Outcomes Measurement System – Treatment (CalOMS-Tx).

DISCUSSION

Pursuant to California Health and Safety Code Section 11755(o), ADP can require alcohol and other drug programs providing publicly funded services or services licensed by ADP to report client data. This statute does not distinguish between private-pay and publicly-assisted clients, and does not limit ADP's data collection to data only about publicly-assisted clients.

Federal and State confidentiality laws (Health and Safety Code section 11845.5(a); 42 U.S.C., Section 290dd-2; and 42 C.F.R., Part 2) also do not distinguish between private-pay and publicly-assisted clients, and do not have more protections for private-pay clients compared to publicly-assisted clients.
