Medi-Cal DRG 3M Grouper Settings for CA State Fiscal Year 2017/2018 (10/10/17)

The purpose of this document is to provide users with the setup parameters for the 3MTM APR-DRG desktop grouper for CA state fiscal year 2017/2018 (SFY 17-18), claims with admission dates beginning 7/1/17 through 6/30/18. The recommended settings shown in this document correspond to the settings used within the California Medicaid Management System (CAMMIS) mainframe grouper, which pays Medi-Cal DRG claims.

Some important points to consider:

- Medi-Cal policy for each SFY is applied based upon the admission date of the claim. The grouper settings must be set to Keyed by: Admit date.
- These settings will vary based on the claims' admission and discharge dates. See Table 1 and Figures 1 and 2 for full details of settings to enter.
 - Interpretation of Undetermined POA Indicators: The POA indicators of W and U will be treated as N by the system.
 - HAC version: For admissions from 7/1/17 through 9/30/17, use HAC version 34.0 for California Medicaid. For admissions on or after 10/1/17, use HAC version 35.0 for Medicaid. This will be updated once 3M releases the California specific 35.0 version.
 - Entered code mapping: For admissions from 7/1/17 through 9/30/17 with a discharge date before 10/1/2017, Entered code mapping: should be set to None. For admissions from 7/1/17 through 6/30/18 with a discharge date on or after 10/1/2017, Entered code mapping: should be set to ICD-10-CM/PCS Version 35.0 effective 10/01/2017.
 - Mapping type: Discharge dates prior to 10/1/17 do not require mapping, discharge dates on or after 10/1/17 require historical mapping.

- 1. The discharge date determines the need for historical mapping.
- 2. In order for new diagnoses and procedures effective 10/1/17 to be included in the DRG assignment, the updated APR-DRG Mapper must be implemented.

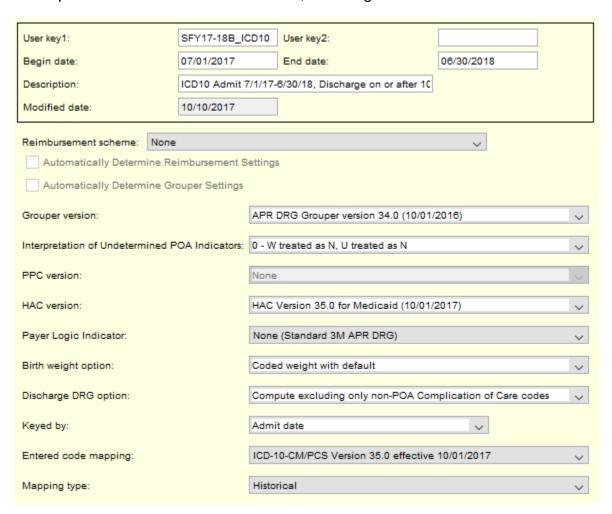
